Thank you for registering your capabilities on the Unmanned Air Systems Capability Development Centre (UAS CDC) Open Supplier Register (OSR). Based on the information submitted onto the OSR you have indicated to us that you have:

- Class 1 (Micro, Mini, Small) UAS capabilities;
- Have a UAS operating capability.

As such, you may be interested in receiving further details of a forthcoming UAS CDC opportunity that has arisen.

**Royal Navy Aerial Survey Demonstration**

The Royal Navy is looking to evaluate the use of small UAS for routine tasks and as such, has identified surveying ship infrastructure 'at height' as an area where small UAS can potentially be exploited.

To demonstrate the utility of small UAS to carry out structural survey tasks on Naval vessels, the UAS CDC is seeking potential suppliers to undertake a limited demonstration of small UAS capability. The demonstration will be conducted in one day at a UK Naval dockyard, likely to be on the South Coast of England.

The UAS CDC is looking to work with CAA-approved UAS operators from its OSR, who have experience of conducting structural surveys using small UAS.

Prior to issue of the Request For Quote (RFQ), the suppliers may have the opportunity to attend a briefing session at MOD Boscombe Down regarding the task. **The briefing session is not mandatory and will not exclude the supplier from receiving the RFQ.**
