



**Expression of Interest Notice for Potential UAS Providers**

Thank you for registering your capabilities on the Unmanned Air Systems Capability Development Centre (UAS CDC) Open Supplier Register (OSR). Based on the information submitted onto the OSR you have indicated to us that you have:

- Class 1 (Micro, Mini, Small) UAS Capabilities;
- Have a UAS Operating Capability.

As such, you may be interested in receiving further details of a potential forthcoming UAS CDC opportunity that has arisen.

**Counter Small UAS Demonstration**

The UAS CDC has received an initial requirement to supply Small UAS (SUAS) and operators to a demonstration of SUAS detect and track technologies in an 'urban' environment. The 'urban' area will be in a controlled, non-public, training area.

The demonstration will take place from 11<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> March 2016 in the UK. Actual location is to be confirmed but is expected to be in central/southern England or South Wales. Flying will consist of accurately repeating consistent flight profile(s) between buildings to enable assessment of the SUAS detect and track technologies being demonstrated. Flight inside of buildings is not currently envisaged.

The required platform type is common market leader type quadcopters.

If you are interested in this opportunity, should the trial go ahead, please confirm your availability to support together with details of the UAS platform type that you are able to offer.
